FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What is an institutional subscription?

For the most part, an Institutional Online Subscription authorizes access to the AJEV and the Catalyst websites at a localized site. A "site" is an organizational unit and may be academic or nonacademic. For organizations located in more than one city, each city office is considered a different site. For organizations within the same city that are administered independently, each office is considered a different site. For example, each campus in the University of California system is considered a different site, and each branch or office of UpJohn Laboratories is considered a different site.

Who from an institution may access AJEV and Catalyst Online?

The subscription fee allows for unrestricted Internet access at one location for computers within a particular set of IP (Internet Protocol) addresses. Any user connecting from an authorized computer on your institutional network will be allowed access to AJEV and the Catalyst, which includes current volumes and complete AJEV archives (1950 onward). (An IP address is the numeric address of a computer connected to a network. The IP address is sometimes also known as the Internet address. On most networks, each computer has its own IP address. An IP address is not the same as a domain name or an email address.)

How does institutional access work?

When someone attempts to access AJEV and the Catalyst, a file server confirms whether the requesting computer is within the list of IP addresses provided by a subscribing institution. If it is, the reader will be able to use all those services enabled for institutional readers. For institutional subscribers, there are no usernames or passwords to remember and there is currently no limit on the number of readers from your institution who may access AJEV and the Catalyst simultaneously. (If readers want to access AJEV and the Catalyst from computers that are not part of your institutional network [e.g., through dial-in or telnet through a commercial Internet service provider], they can do so only through their individual ASEV member online subscription.)

What are the prices for institutional access?

You may purchase an online only or print and online subscription. There are two levels (tiers) of pricing, depending on the institution. Please refer to the fees above.

How does an institution order and activate their subscription?

(1) Place an order for AJEV and the Catalyst by contacting ASEV directly (530-753-3142 or society@asev.org) or through your subscription agent, who will contact ASEV. ASEV will confirm the tier level of your institution and will then invoice you accordingly. **(2) Payment should be made to your subscription agent or directly to ASEV.** **(3) Once ASEV has received payment, you will receive a letter with instructions for obtaining access to AJEV and the Catalyst; the letter will direct you to an online form. You will be asked to provide the following information necessary to activate your subscription to AJEV and the Catalyst:**

- Institution's IP Address(es)
- Contact name, title, phone, fax, and email
- Customer number (assigned to you by ASEV)

We will send you the address of this web form and instructions for completing it after we verify payment. Your institution will not have access to AJEV and the Catalyst articles until you activate your subscription. **NO REFUNDS WILL BE ISSUED.**

Missing issues claimed within the allowed time frame will be replaced once. **REFUNDS WILL NOT BE ISSUED.**
